

Templum Tu'at Messenger Speech

Welcome to the Triune Mass presented by Templum Tu'at Priory. We ask that you please turn your cell phones off and remove your shoes. If you need to use the restroom before Mass starts, now is the time. If this is your first Triune Mass, keep your eyes on me and watch for the cues I will be explaining momentarily. On each chair inside the Temple you will find a missal. You may use it to follow along with the ritual, if it be your will.

There are two versions of the Creed. There is the original Gnostic Creed and the alternative, non-gendered Creed. You may recite either version you wish.

There are a few instances where something I say requires a response from the Congregation. When I say, "Do What Thou Wilt Shall Be the Whole of the Law", the proper response is, "Love is the Law. Love Under Will." Let's all give that a try. (Demonstrate).

When I say, "ALL HAIL!" the proper response is "So mote it be!" along with the Hailing Sign of a Magician. That is, like the Pledge of Allegiance, the

right hand is placed over your heart with the thumb extended and the left arm at a 90 degree angle with the thumb extended. (Demonstrate).

At one point of this ritual you will be directed by me to kneel and assume the “horseshoe” position, that is, kneeling with the arms and hands extended toward the person to either side of you. It is not necessary to touch, if it is not your will. Let’s try that too. (Demonstrate).

The Temple is split into two sides. The “Binah” or “Mother” side is... (Demonstrate) and the “Chokmah” or “Father” is... (Demonstrate). You are welcome to sit on whichever side you personally identify or feel comfortable with. During the Anthem portion of the Mass certain lines are recited by the Binah side of the Temple and others by the Chokmah side. All of this the Congregation takes part in, if it be their will.

This is a Eucharistic ritual and the Congregation is required to partake. If you do not wish to participate in the Eucharist of Cakes of Light and wine or juice, we politely and respectfully ask that you do not enter the Temple and wait out here. The Cakes of Light may contain what is referred to as Ingredient X. This is one single small cake made with one drop of blood and possibly other bodily fluids. This cake is cooked until completely reduced to ash. One pinch of this ash is then added to an entire batch of Cakes of Light.

Each congregant will come forward to partake of the sacrament offered by the Children. After consuming, the arms are crossed over the chest, right over left like so... (Demonstrate) and the following is stated, "There is no part of me that is not of the gods."

Templum Tu'at Priory and TTO are proud to place transparency, safety, and consent as the most important elements in anything we do. We openly disclose that you may see nudity during this ritual. If this is something you may not be comfortable with, we respectfully ask that you wait out here. If you have any allergies or physical issues you feel may hinder your active participation in the Triune Mass, please let us know.

Let us now enter the Temple in silence.
